In 2021, SUISA's turnover consisted of revenues from the authors' rights and secondary income.

121.4 mn

for authors and publishers

In 2021, SUISA reported revenues of CHF 121.4 mn which were passed on to publishers, lyricists and composers.

2.3 mn

for Swiss music

In 2021, SUISA promoted Swiss music, allocating CHF 2.3 mn for this purpose to the FONDATION SUISA. From this, composers and lyricists profited.

SUISA serves the needs of its members and clients with a staff of 223 employees, corresponding to 186.1 fulltime jobs.

for the artists

For each CHF 100 in revenues, SUISA distributes CHF 87 to rightsholders.

4,263,202

declarations of works

SUISA has received 4,263,202 declarations of works in 2021. This demonstrates how active composers are.

sister societies

In Switzerland, SUISA represents the world repertoire of music, and clears authors' rights with over 100 sister societies worldwide.

8.9 mn

broadcasts

In 2021, SUISA licensed radio and television broadcasts for about CHF 8.9 mn, representing more than 360,000 works.

6.8 mn

for social security

7.5% of the revenues from performance and broadcasting rights in Switzerland and Liechtenstein are contributed to the social security of our members. In 2021, this represented CHF 6.8 mn.

31.8 mn

administration expenses

Secondary income (CHF 15.4 mn) covers a portion of the expenses. The rest is financed by deducting a contribution from the settlements distributed to beneficiaries. This cost-coverage deduction was 12.7% on average
